### CLAY TARGET SHOOTING CLINIC APPLICATION FORM

#### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The 'Future Athletes Program' is an initiative of the Victorian Government designed to introduce secondary school age students competing in representative school events to a wider developmental pathway in their sport. During 2005 the Victorian Institute of Sport, in conjunction with the 16 Commonwealth Games sports associations, will conduct sport specific clinics providing:

- Technical Tips from leading Coaches
- Training advice from a State or National representative Athlete
- Valuable information on Sports Nutrition, Training and Injury Prevention
- Skill Practice and Assessment
- Information on how to take the 'next step' in sporting development

**Clinics are scheduled from 10:00am until 3:30pm, and are free of charge to participants.**

#### ELIGIBILITY and SELECTION to ATTEND a CLAY TARGET SHOOTING CLINIC

All Victorian secondary school students who meet the selection criteria may enrol in a 'Clay Target' shooting clinic. Selection criteria have been developed in consultation with the Sporting Shooters Association – Victoria (SSAA), Field and Game Australia and the Victorian Clay Target Association (VCTA) to assist athletes in taking the 'next step' in their sporting development. A minimum age requirement has been set for athletes who wish to take part a Clay Target Shooting Clinic. Clinics will be limited to 40 shooters; applications may be rejected when each clinic is full.

To be eligible to attend a 'Future Athlete' Shooting Clinic:

- Students must submit a signed application form to the VIS prior to the scheduled clinic.
- Applicants must be at least 12 years of age and currently enrolled in a Victorian secondary school (both government and non-government school students are eligible).
- Applicants must have competed in a school or club shooting competition during 2003, 2004 or 2005.
- For current VCTA shooters, students must be nominated by the zone chairman.
- For all other shooters the application needs to be endorsed by a school teacher or club committee member.

Please note:

- Students do not need to be current members of a shooting club to qualify for a spot in these clinics.
- Students may attend only one 'Future Athletes Program' sports clinic.
