Selection Criteria**

Program Objective

The VIS Golf Program provides the state's leading young male and female amateur and professional golfers with services and support to assist them in realising their full potential.

Eligibility

- Athletes must be Australian citizens or have Permanent Resident status
- Athletes will be residents in the State of Victoria

Selection Criteria

- Perceived potential to achieve at international amateur or professional level
- Prior performance record

Selection Panel

- VIS Golf Head Coach
- VIS Golf Assistant Coach
- VIS Performance Manager
- Delegates from PGA, Golf Australia and Golf Victoria

Process of selection

Scholarship application forms will be made available in January on the VIS, PGA and Golf Victoria websites. Applicants are short-listed by the selection panel based on the extent to which they satisfy the selection criteria and further discussed at the VIS Golf Program Management Meeting in February where selections will be ratified by the panel. Applicants may be interviewed by the selection panel to determine suitability for the program if required. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application.

Scholarship term
